



Car Care Basics for Teen Drivers

Curriculum

Under the hood: engine, battery, transmission, radiator. Locate the items that need the most frequent attention - the oil dipstick and filter, the coolant reservoir, and the washer fluid bottle.

Two-week checks: spare tire, tire pressures, check the battery for corrosion, check all the lights - back-up, taillights, and break lights, check oil level with dipstick, check fluid levels.

Fuses and their uses: avoid getting stranded from a blown fuse.

Gauges and “idiot” lights: what they are and what they represent. Understand the normal ranges, knowing to pull over and call for advice at the next safe place if the overheating light or the low oil light, or low oil pressure light comes on.

Safe use of the jack and the safe way to change a tire.

“Trouble” sounds: Learning to listen to the car, and to pay attention if something sounds strange.

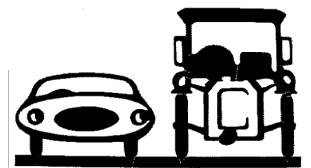
Give teen drivers a good general idea of the importance of car care and maintenance for the well-being of their vehicles and themselves!
